 - 1) Signed confirmation e-mail (sent to you after completion of online packet)
 - 2) Completed Sports Physical
 - a. Physical must be completed AFTER June 1st and BEFORE June 4th.** (can be completed at SD High School on Saturday, June 1 at 9am OR on your own, at any CVS Minute Clinic, or by prearranging a physical with your personal physician on June 1st, 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} .)
 - 3) Medical Insurance Card

**Note: The district changed Athletic Clearance date this year. We realize this is a very small window in which to receive athletic clearance and have made every arrangement possible to assist cheerleaders in getting clearance prior to the tryout date.

Before Tryouts:

- It is required that each candidate complete and submit a Cheerleading Tryout Application
- It is <u>required</u> that each candidate complete the district's Athletic Clearance protocol, which includes proof of valid health insurance and a physical exam performed AFTER June 1st AND BEFORE the tryout start date June 4, 2019**
 - **We realize this is a very small window in which to receive athletic clearance and have made every arrangement possible to assist cheerleaders in getting clearance within that window. They MUST be cleared in order to tryout.
 - a. Athletic Clearance can be completed at www.AthleticClearance.com (on or after June 1, 2019).
 - b. After you have completed the online clearance forms, it is **required** that each candidate submit the following to Brian Carter (in person or electronically to bcarter@sandi.net):
 - i. Signed Confirmation e-mail (sent to you after completion of online packet)
 - ii. Completed Sports Physical (link found within online Athletic Packet)
 - iii. Photocopy of Student's Medical Insurance Card
- Athletic Clearance forms must be 100% completed and submitted to Mr. Carter in the PLHS Office on or before 2PM on June 4, 2019. (Note Athletic Clearance is not part of the package submitted to Mrs. Denney).
- It is <u>required</u> that each candidate and their parent(s) or legal guardian fill out, sign and submit **signature pages** for the **PLHS Cheerleading Tryout Contract** as well as the **PLHS Cheerleading Handbook**.
- It is <u>required</u> that each candidate submit a copy of their Official 12-Week Progress Report, handed out on May 13, 2019; or a copy of his/her 1st semester Report Card only if attending a school outside of the SDUSD.
 - a. Each candidate must prove tryout eligibility of a 2.5 Academic GPA & 2.5 Citizenship GPA.
 - b. All candidates must be enrolled in PLHS for the 2019-20 School Year <u>on or before</u> June 1, 2019. (Dual enrollment is not allowed in conjunction with Charter Schools). Late tryouts will be made available for transfer students.
- It is required that each candidate submit a picture with their application (no larger than 4"x6").

IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN CHEER TRYOUTS, <u>ALL OF THE ABOVE</u> MUST BE COMPLETED AND TURNED IN AS DESCRIBED.

Mrs. Denney will be available in room 405 during lunch period every day between Monday 5/20/2019 and Thursday 5/23/19, OR after school until 3:15PM on Thursday 5/23/2019.

Mr. Carter will be available in the PLHS Office until 2:15pm on Monday 6/3/2019 and Tuesday 6/4/19

NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!

Tryouts:

• Candidates must submit all tryout paperwork on or before May 23, 2019 (the week prior to Cheer Tryouts) and Athletic Clearance on June 3 or June 4.

- The tryout process will begin with the clinic on Tuesday, May 28, 2019 and conclude with tryouts on Tuesday, June 4, 2019. Candidates will learn a dance, a cheer, jumps, kicks, stunting skills and the PLHS Alma Mater.
- All candidates with approved paperwork who have been cleared to tryout must report to the PLHS Dance Room for check-in at the designated time on the first day of Tryout Clinics (Tuesday, May 28th). If a candidate's name is not on the check-in list, the candidate will not be allowed to tryout.
- The tryout clinics and interviews for both J.V. and Varsity will be conducted during the hours of 2:30-5:30 pm in the PLHS Dance Room.
 - 1) Tuesday, May 28th: Varsity: 2:30 check in; 2:45-4:00 tryout clinic // J.V.- 4:00pm check in; 4:10-5:30 tryout clinic
 - 2) Thursday, May 30th: Varsity: 2:30 check in; 2:45-4:00 tryout clinic // J.V.- 4:00pm check in; 4:10-5:30 tryout clinic
 - 3) Monday, June 3rd: Varsity: 2:30 check in; 2:45-4:00 tryout clinic // J.V.- 4:00pm check in; 4:10-5:30 tryout clinic
- Interviews will be conducted randomly throughout the tryout clinic days.
- On the final day of tryouts, candidates will perform skills learned throughout the tryout clinic in front of a panel of judges. Candidates will tryout in groups assigned by Coach Chavez on Thursday, May 30th. This is your moment to really shine. Present yourself well, smile, and keep going.
- Candidates with the highest total scores from all portions of the tryout process will make the 2019-2020 squads.
- Incoming Freshmen are only eligible for the Junior Varsity squad and Seniors are only eligible for the Varsity squad (exceptions can be made for transfer or new-to-cheer students). Sophomores and Juniors may be placed on either squad depending on overall scores and space available per squad; Sophomores and Juniors have the option to try out for Varsity only, or J.V. and Varsity (the selection must be made on the candidates application and cannot be altered once the tryout clinic has begun).

Areas of Judging:

- Interview Each candidate will meet individually with the Coach/Advisor for approximately 2-3 minutes. Candidates will be judged on honesty, sincerity, and overall impression given (up to 20 pts.)
- **Appearance** Candidates are expected to have a well-groomed appearance. Hair must be worn up. Appropriate make-up is allowed. Showing creativity and spirit in overall appearance is encouraged (up to 5 pts.)
- Cheer Candidates will be judged on motion technique, precision, placement, timing, vocal projection and enthusiasm (up to 10 pts.)
- Dance Candidates will be judged on motion technique, timing and showmanship (up to 10 pts.)
- **Jumps**—Each candidate will be asked to perform a jump of their choice and a toe touch which will be judged on motion technique, flexibility and height (up to 10 pts.)
- Kicks- Each candidate will be asked to kick five times in succession on each leg (up to 5 pts.)
- Alma Mater Candidates will be asked to sing the Alma Mater during the tryout clinic (up to 10 pts.)
- **Tumbling*** Candidates with tumbling skills (minimum <u>clean</u> standing back hand spring) (up to 10 pts.)
- Stunting* Candidates will be judged on their willingness to stunt and do different positions (up to 10 pts.)

• Overall Spirit/Attitude* – Candidates will be evaluated by the Coach/Advisor on their attitude throughout the entire tryout process. Points may be added or subtracted from a candidate's overall score as deemed appropriate.

*Denotes an optional category where candidates have the opportunity to earn <u>extra points</u> towards their overall tryout score.

Candidates will be notified of any changes made to areas of judging during the tryout clinic.

Tryout Results:

- While the selection process is one that allows for equal opportunity to all candidates, it is understood that not all who try out will be selected.
- After the judging panel deliberates and scores are totaled the Preliminary 2019-2020 JV & Varsity squads will be posted on the PLHS Cheer website (www.pointlomacheer.com) between the hours of 8:00 and 10:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 4th. Results will also be posted on the PLHS Cheer Instagram account.

Preliminary squad members along with 1-2 alternates for each squad will be selected, however only the preliminary squad will be posted. Squad results are not official/final until enrollment has been re-verified.

- Any cheerleader who makes the preliminary squad, but is not enrolled as a PLHS student will forfeit his/her spot to the first alternate, whose enrollment must also then be verified.
- Final squad results will be posted within 24 hours of Coach/Advisor receipt of enrollment verification.

Mandatory New Squad & Parent Meeting:

• June 7th, 2019: 5:30-7:30pm in the Point Loma High School Cafeteria. Check email & the PLHS Cheer website for updates/changes.

2019/2020 PE Credit and Practice Scheduling:

- It is not yet known whether or not Sideline Cheer practices will be held during school-class period or held after school. This decision is up to the Administration at Point Loma High.
- That decision will also determine whether or not Sideline Cheer will be counted as a PE credit, and therefore graded as such.
- As soon as that determination is made, cheerleaders will be made aware.

Summer Practices: For the most updated schedule, please check the website calendar at www.pointlomacheer.com.

- Full squad attendance is *pertinent* at all practices, due to the intricate partnering in dance routines and stunts, and is thus required; summer practice absences could affect the cheerleader's semester 1 grade; please plan accordingly.
- All squad members are expected to come to practices on time, in appropriate attire (athletic support bra, any athletic/Spandex short, no loose-fitting tank tops, no display of the midriff), and ready to participate; again, dress out, punctuality and presence could affect cheerleaders' semester 1 grade.
- Every effort should be made to schedule vacations, appointments and other commitments <u>around these</u> dates/times.
- The inability to attend summer practices will result in game suspension <u>and</u> may result in dismissal from the squad. See the PLHS Cheerleading Handbook for specific consequences for missed practices and events.

Practices, Games & Events:

- During the school year, Varsity practice days and times are still TBD, as previously stated. Practices will either be
 held on campus, during a class period, or afterschool, location TBD. This will be confirmed as soon as PLHS
 Administration has determined scheduling.
- During the school year, **Junior Varsity** practice days and times are still TBD, as previously stated. Practices will either be held on campus, during a class period, or afterschool, location TBD. This will be confirmed as soon as PLHS Administration has determined scheduling.
- If Sideline Cheer is scheduled as a class period, both J.V. & Varsity Cheerleaders will earn Athletic P.E. credit and a grade. Asyllabus with the grading policy and expected attire for the class will be distributed once that determination is made.
- Throughout the year, cheerleaders will be attending various school athletic activities. These include but are not limited to: football, basketball, soccer, baseball, water polo, and wrestling. Students will also participate in team fundraisers, pep rallies, and community events.

- All practices, games, pep rallies and community events will be supervised by the Coach and/or Advisor. Squad
 members are not permitted to perform stunts or tumbling without the supervision of the Coach. Failure to follow
 this rule will result in possible benching/dismissal from the squad.
- Missing practices and/or events including team fundraisers will result in game suspension and may result in dismissal from the squad. A three-strike policy will be set in place (See Cheerleading Handbook).
- Sideline Cheer is a full-time commitment from June 2019-March 2020.

Safety Regulations:

- Cheerleaders, Coaches and the Advisor are expected to follow the safety guidelines set forth by the AACCA. The Coaches are certified.
- Expected Behavior and Standards:
 - a. In and out of uniform as well as on and off campus, PLHS Cheerleaders will behave in a way that proudly represents Point Loma High School.
 - b. PLHS Cheerleaders will be expected to follow all school and athletic rules. Please refer to the school's catalog, Athletic Packet and PLHS Cheerleading Handbook for specific rules and regulations.
- Failure to follow these rules may result in benching or dismissal from the team.

Expenses/Fundraising:

- Team fundraising events will be held during the summer, and throughout the school year to ensure that PLHS Cheer is able to exist this year and in the future.
- Attendance at team fundraisers is mandatory just like attendance at any game or event.
- Without team fundraising efforts, there will be no more PLHS Cheer!

We encourage all candidates and their families to discuss the amount of time, effort, dedication and responsibility that goes into participating in PLHS Cheer *before* making the decision to tryout.

You will be responsible for knowing the information contained herein and will be held liable for it.
